The Lutheran Church in Great Britain will be meeting for a Special Synod on Saturday 30 January 2010 at St Anne's Lutheran Church, Gresham Street, London EC2V 7BX at 10.30am

The main business of the Synod is to discuss the necessary constitutional changes for LCiGB which will enable us to register as a Charity. The following Resolution will be voted on during the Meeting:

“That the Memorandum of Association and the Articles of Association of the Lutheran Church in Great Britain in the form of the drafts produced to the meeting be adopted in substitution for and to the exclusion of the existing Constitution of the Lutheran Church in Great Britain.”

The proposed Memorandum and Articles, and the Statement of Faith that will form an integral part of the new Constitution, as well Minutes of the previous Synod, are attached to this email. All documents will be clearly explained on the day of the Synod.

This is a vital meeting for all pastors and delegates to attend, as this is a historic development for our church.
